

One-stop enrollment for new-to-district families and students

The Anchorage School District is offering a special earlier enrollment and registration opportunity for families. Parents will be able to enroll all students at one location and speak with ASD department representatives to assist them in areas such as assessment, nursing services, counseling, community services, before and after-school care and more.

This event is specifically geared to the following types of families:

New-to-district families:

- Elementary
 - Kindergarten students should register at their regular school during registration week.
- Middle
- High
- Families with children at multiple schools

Returning families:

- English Language Learners
- Military
- Child in Transition
- Migrant
- Special Education

To complete enrollment, parents must bring:

- ☐ **Proof of residency**, such as a utility or phone bill, contract of purchase or lease agreement.
- ☐ Current official record of immunization:
 - Diphtheria, pertussis and tetanus
 - Polio
 - Measles, mumps and rubella
 - Hepatitis A
 - Hepatitis B
 - Varicella (two doses are required for K-6)
- ☐ **Bring your students** with you that you are registering.

Plan to spend two hours to complete the enrollment and registration process.
