The House Finance Committee recently ignored the Governor's FY 01 budget and introduced new budget caps, which reduced the governor's FY 01 increase to the Health and Social Services budget. The new numbers from the majority members of the House Finance Committee reflect a \$22 million decrease from the governor's proposal. The House H&SS budget subcommittee will be tasked to propose the reductions. The rumor in the capitol is **medicaid** will be targeted for the brunt of the reductions. The Governor Proposes the Supplemental Budget

The Governor introduced HB 343, the supplemental budget on Wednesday. The purpose of the supplemental budget is to provide adequate funds to divisions who were underfunded during the previous budget cycle. The Governor's supplemental request is for \$16.5 million. Two of the major areas the Governor has requested additional general fund monies for are the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development and the Department of Health and Social Services. Here are some items the administration has requested funding for in General Fund dollars:
