Sixty years ago, 55 Alaskans reflected on their work crafting the Constitution of the State of Alaska. They were from all walks of life, with differing beliefs and ideologies, each strong-minded with equally strong opinions. Working as a single caucus, they completed a task which tested a different kind of strength - Who was strong enough to compromise?
