You wished to know the amount spent during the past three years by the Knik Arm Bridge and Toll Authority (KABATA) and the Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) on print, radio, television, and internet advertising for the Knik Arm Bridge and the Susitna-Watana Dam projects, respectively.

We received the following in response to our query:

## Knik Arm Bridge:

The Knik Arm Crossing project spent \$58,633.06 on print, radio and internet media for public outreach during state fiscal years 2012, 2013, and 2014 to date (31 months). No television [advertising] was used.

## Susitna-Watana Hydroelectric project:

• Most of our efforts have been to drive people to our website, including a limited-run radio ad and some online advertising publicizing the project website. This fall we printed a flier insert that highlighted the results of our 2012 environmental studies and licensing updates. This was inserted into newspapers across the Railbelt as a way to directly reach Alaskans. It has also been used as our project flier when we deliver presentations or visit with stakeholders. The total spent on these efforts during the past three years is \$71,001.80.
