- 4 * **Section 1.** AS 14.17.520(a) is amended to read:
- 5 (a) A district shall budget for and spend a minimum of <u>the following</u> 6 <u>percentages</u> [70 PERCENT] of its school operating expenditures in each fiscal year
- 7 on the instructional component of the district budget:

8	School ADM	Required expenditures
9	Less than 200	70 percent
10	At least 200 but less than 301	75 percent
11	At least 301 but less than 401	80 percent
12	<u>401 or more</u>	85 percent.
