**A BILL****FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to a minimum expenditure for the instruction component in a public  
 2 school budget; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 14.17.520(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) A district shall budget for and spend a minimum of the following  
 6 percentages [70 PERCENT] of its school operating expenditures in each fiscal year  
 7 on the instructional component of the district budget;

8	<u>School ADM</u>	<u>Required expenditures</u>
9	<u>Less than 200</u>	<u>70 percent</u>
10	<u>At least 200 but less than 301</u>	<u>75 percent</u>
11	<u>At least 301 but less than 401</u>	<u>80 percent</u>
12	<u>401 or more</u>	<u>85 percent.</u>

13 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 14.17.520(f) is amended to read:

14 (f) In this section,

2                   **(1)** "instructional component" includes expenditures for teachers and  
3 for pupil support services;

4                   **(2) "school ADM" means the district ADM divided by the number**  
5 **of schools in the district.**

6    \* **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2003.
