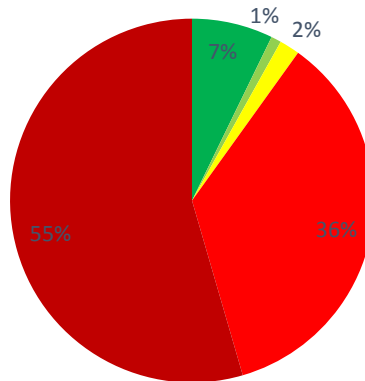


1. How concerned are you about the current state of Alaska budget shortfall?

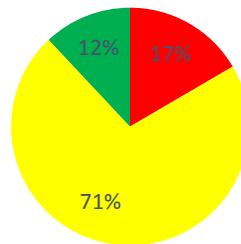

No more cuts, focus on new revenues

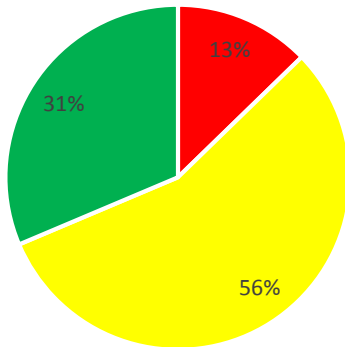

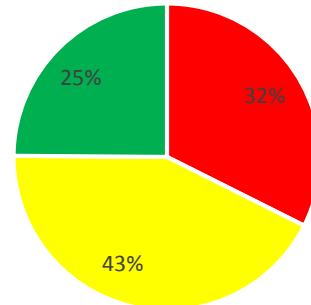

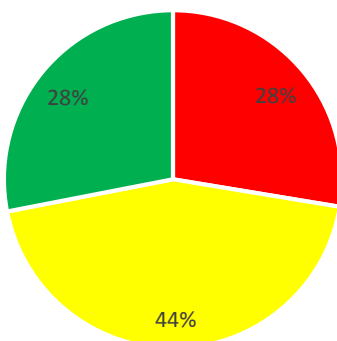

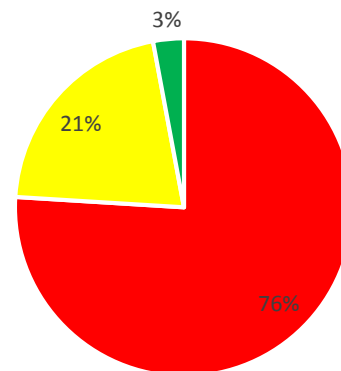

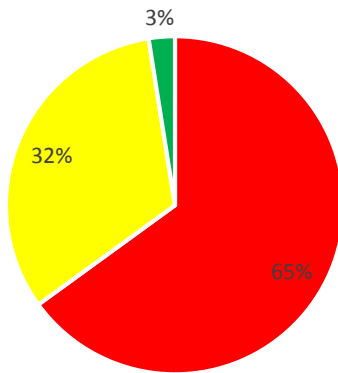

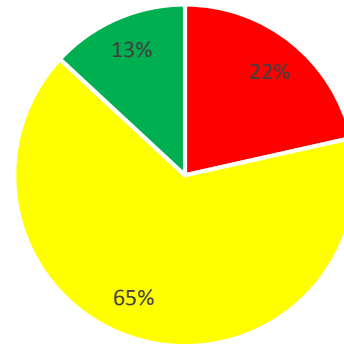

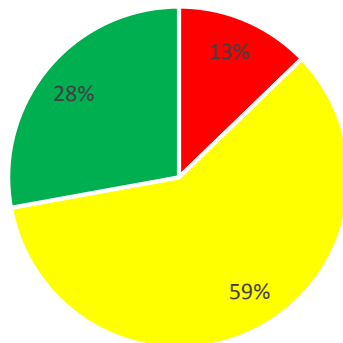

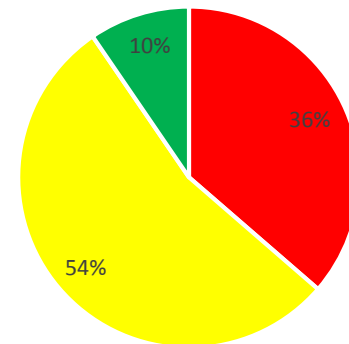

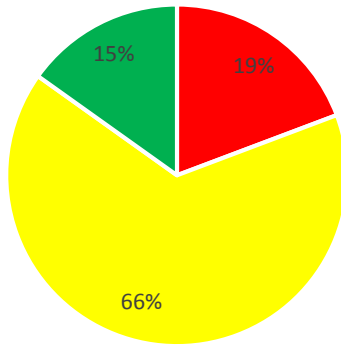

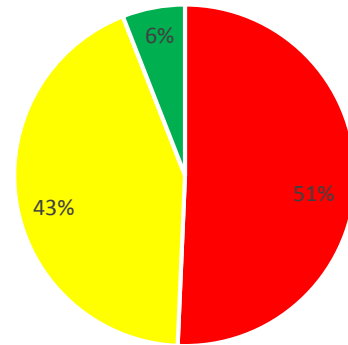

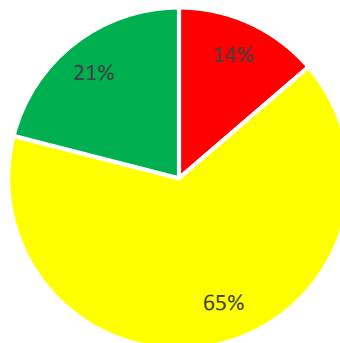

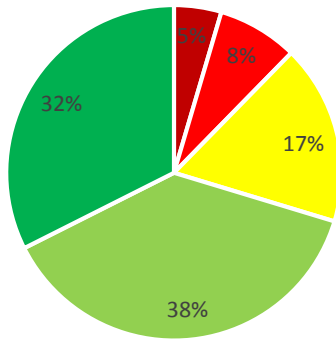

Increase Revenue from Oil

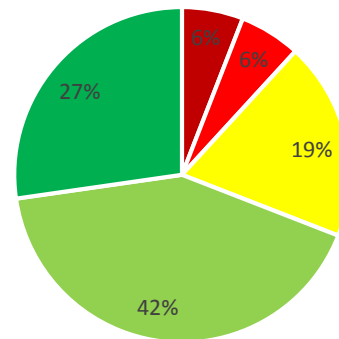

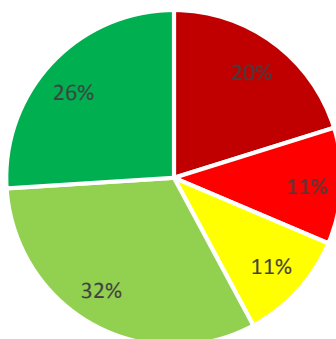

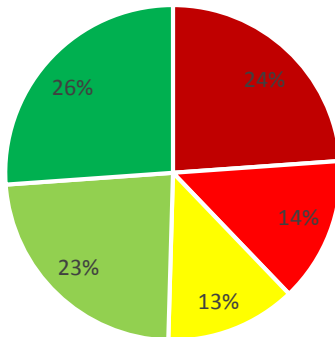

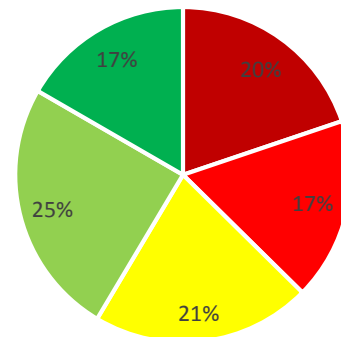

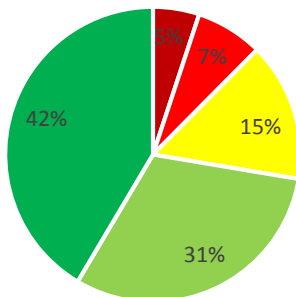

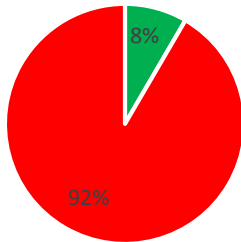

5. Do you think the state has enough money at this time to fund the following projects? (Please select one per project)

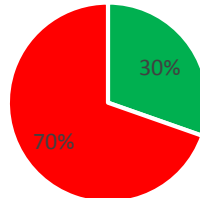
Knik Arm Bridge

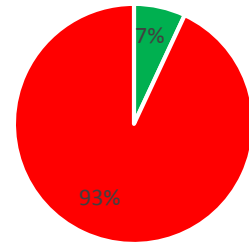
Susitna Watana Hydroelectric Dam

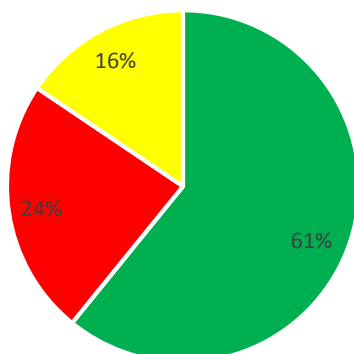
